

2010 BROOMBALL LEAGUE RULES

Leagues will be governed by MSF Official State Broomball Rules except the following:

1. Outdoor leagues will have two periods of 25 minutes running time. Stop time – the last 2 minutes, if there is a 1 goal difference. 2 or more goal lead or tied game the clock runs.
2. Size of goal cages shall be 8 feet in width and 4½ feet in height (outdoors).
3. Each team must supply one official game ball at the start of game.
Official Ball - Baden 332 Acacia “King 21”
4. Grace period - only the 6:00 p.m. games will have a 10 minute grace period to field a team. After ten minutes the game will be declared a forfeit: **The referee’s watch is official.**
 - a. Six players - a team must have six players to start the game or a forfeit will be declared, Co-Rec , 3 Men, 3 Women). Women can play goalie in the Co-Rec 6 person league
 - b. Eight Players (eight players - a team may start and complete a game with seven (7) players. (Men & Women’s Recreation). Co-Rec 4 men and 4 women: If a team has only 7 players, the team composition must be four (4) women and three (3) men.
5. Regular season games that end in a tie will remain a tie.
6. Helmets:
 - a. **Goalies must wear hockey helmet with facemask.**
 - b. Other players are strongly recommended to wear some type of head and face protection.
7. Goalie or other style leg pads and blocking pads are prohibited.
8. *Draw-backs will be used when ball is frozen by the goalie or when the net is knocked out of place. All other turnovers will result in a face-off with the offending team being penalized 1 zone.
9. Delayed Whistle- If a foul is committed by one team while the other team is in possession of the ball, the stoppage of play shall be delayed until the offending team obtains possession and control of the ball.
10. Body checking is totally eliminated from the program.
