REGISTRATIONS WILL BE DONE ONLINE

- THERE will be a link on our website to follow for registration.
- Registration Begins February 23rd at 9:00am and will be on a first come first serve basis

PLAYER REGISTRATION REQUIRED FOR ALL TEAMS:

- All schedules and receipts will be emailed to managers and will be available on the MPRB website. Schedules will be available at a minimum two weeks before the season starts.
- Roster form **must be completed online** and is due before your first scheduled game.
- Teams not properly registered by respective deadline date **FORFEIT** all consideration for league **championships and tournaments**. Managers are responsible for registering all players by the deadline date.
- Teams may register up to 20 players.

ENTRY FEE & REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

- REGISTRATION WILL BE ONLINE, THERE NO LONGER IS A PRIORITY LIST REGISTRATION BEGINS FEBRUARY 23rd at 9:00AM FOR ALL TEAMS
- There will be a link on our website to follow for registration
- Sponsor checks-You may bring a sponsor check into MPRB Headquarters in place of online registration. Please note that we will not be able to hold a spot for you until we receive payment. In order to hold a spot you will need register for a league using your credit card. If you then bring a sponsor check to the MPRB we will refund your credit card and apply the sponsor check to your account.
