Resolution

The Minneapolis Parks and Recreation Board (MPRB) and DeLaSalle High School reviewing an agreement to establish an athletic field adjacent to DeLaSalle High School that will be available for the school, inner city youth programs and the broader Minneapolis community. In consideration of such an agreement, the High School has also offered its gymnasium facilities for such public use.

The DeLaSalle Athletic Field Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC) was formed to make recommendations to the Minneapolis Parks and Recreation Board (MPRB) that will, among other things, effectively implement this proposed use of the athletic field.

Because the proposed use of these facilities will include the school, inner city youth programs and the broader Minneapolis community, it is recommended that DeLaSalle High School and MPRB work together to develop a process that will ensure this use is fulfilled in an efficient, effective and fair manner.

It is the intent of this resolution to create 'one-stop scheduling' of these facilities, by the school, inner city youth programs and the broader Minneapolis community.

The High School and MPRB are encouraged to establish criteria that will assure appropriate shared access to these facilities. To this end, it is further recommended that the High School and MPRB explore an agency relationship whereby the High School would conduct onsite, 'one-stop scheduling' on behalf of the MPRB and all users.
