## MPRB Service District Areas

The Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board (MPRB) is organized in three service districts:

- **Lakes** – South of 394 and west of 35W, encompassing Southwest Minneapolis.
- **Minnehaha** – South of the Mississippi River and east of 35W, encompassing South Minneapolis.
- **River** – North of the Mississippi River and 394, encompassing North, Northeast and Southeast Minneapolis

Operated by a District Manager, each district team consists of staff from planning, recreation and operations. The Service Districts enable the MPRB to put staff teams and decision-making as close to the community as possible, thus they tailor programs and services to the community's needs.

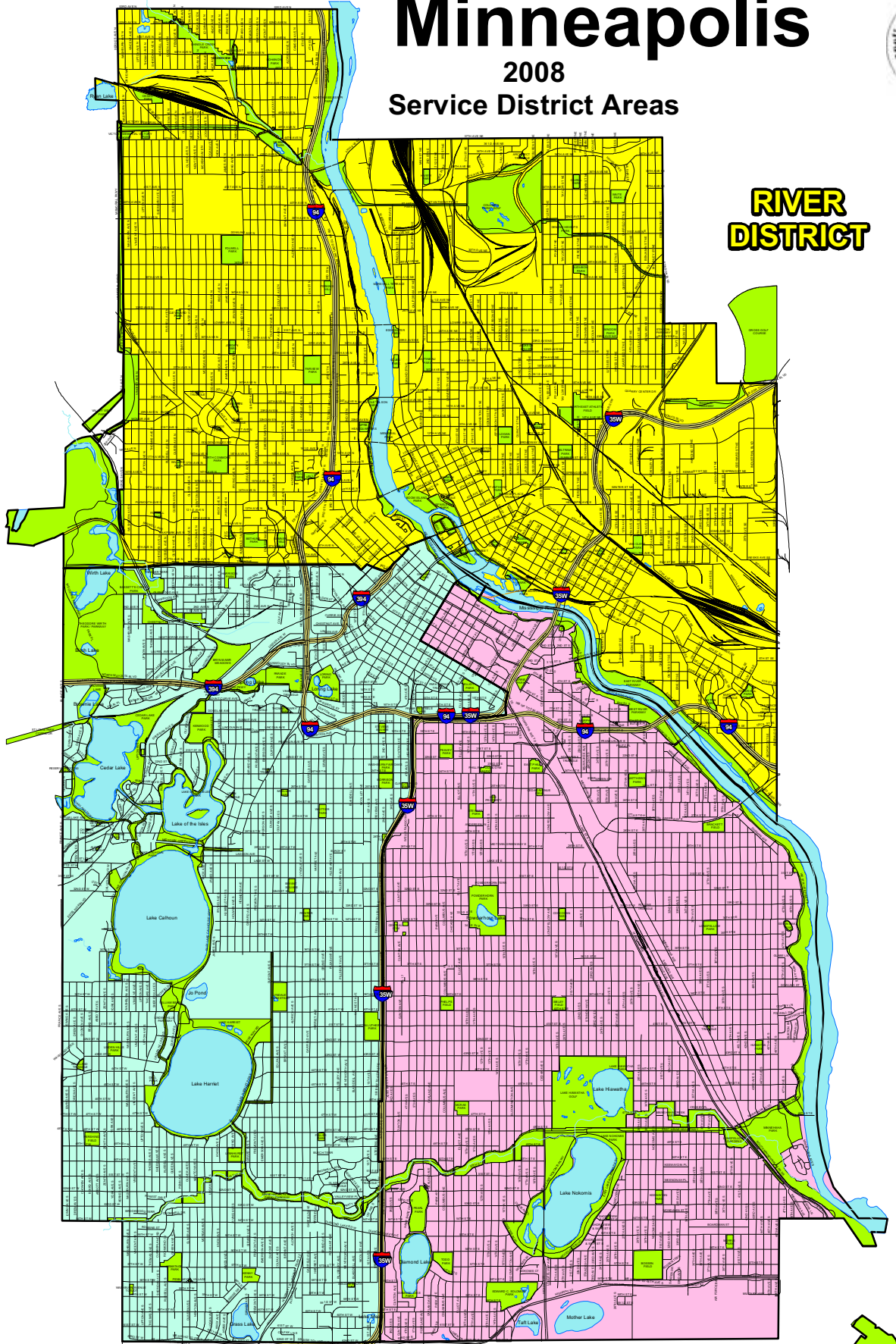
The districts help the MPRB better serve a city that has shifted from a relatively homogeneous population in the 1950s-60s to the diverse population of today. They also position staff and the organization to maintain and implement the comprehensive plan that was adopted in 2007.
