

It's in the Details...

- Reservation may be made 1 year in advance
- Use of the Center beyond 11pm must be approved by the Superintendent of MPRB.
- No gambling is allowed within the center or property.
- A non-refundable \$20 application fee is required for any permit where fees are due but will be applied to the total fees due.
- 50% of the total fees are due upon approval of permit. Payment is due in full 7 days before the date of the event.
- A full refund will be given if cancellation is 15 or more calendar days' before event.
- MPRB reserves the right to revoke a permit if a scheduling conflict or if MPRB program requires the use of the permitted space.
- No alcohol may be brought on or consumed on park property or inside the center.
- Food may be prepared at home or on-site or be catered in for an event.
- Non-Resident consists of a group which is comprised of less than fifty percent Minneapolis residents, as well as to any business which does not have an office or branch located within the corporate limits of Minneapolis.
- Fee includes routine maintenance. Other services including additional lining, dragging, and mowing may be requested at an additional cost.

- \$15/hourr staffing fee is charged when rental occurs outside of regular public hours of rec center.
- A Clean-up/Damage deposit of \$150 will be assessed for groups of 100 or larger.
- Gym use not consistent with usual athletic play such as a banquet, dinner, or reception will incur an additional \$35 fee.
- A \$55/Hour fee for Park Police may be required at the event if there is a large number of people arriving.

Additional Info...

- A permit is required for all non-MPRB leagues, non-MPRB tournaments, and use of a specific facility at a specific time.
- Sales or sales offers, of any item whatsoever is prohibited unless the permit contains sales clauses and procedures.
- Start and finish times listed on permit must be adhered to.
- A daily Land Use Fee will be charged for outdoor events at a rate of \$.25sq. ft., of space permitting.
- A tent fee of \$20/tent for any tent up to 10 X 20 ft. and \$60/tent for larger tents.
- Additional fees will be assessed in which extra lining, dragging or mowing of fields occurs.
