

The Ecological System Plan **INFORMS** the Comp Plan by providing a framework for how the Comp Plan can address ecological concerns.

The Comprehensive Plan **STRENGTHENS** the Ecological System Plan by reinforcing the goals, strategies, and recommendations.

Ecological System Plan ★

Sets **the ecological vision for the entire park system**. The plan will address how environmental impacts from the city can be addressed throughout the park system in order to better protect water, air, land and life.

The Cedar Lake & Lake of the Isles Master Plan **UTILIZES** the goals, strategies, and recommendations outlined in the Ecological System Plan to address ecological concerns within the project area.

The Cedar Lake & Lake of the Isles Master Plan **RESPONDS TO** The Comprehensive Plan. The Comprehensive Plan **BUILDS ON** Master Plans, other policies and activity plans, etc.

MPRB ★

Comprehensive Plan

Represents the **agency's policy direction** based on shared values with community, agency staff and elected officials. The Comp Plan provides guidance in developing policy, establishing or changing programs and series, setting the budget and creating park improvements over the next decade. Acts as a communication tool.

The MPRB is an **INDEPENDENT** government agency (not a department of the City of Minneapolis) which necessitates the creation of the organizations own Comprehensive Plan (separate from the Minneapolis 2040 Plan).

Technical Management Plan

Internal facing plan that provides specific maintenance and operations guidance within a park or geographic location

Cedar Lake and Lake of the Isles Master Plan ★

Part of the Minneapolis Chain of Lakes Regional Park. This master plan will create a vision for the lakes and surrounding parkland for the next 20+ years

This plan is just one example of a **Master Plan** which provides policy and design guidance within a specific park or geographic location.

Example: **Natural Areas Management plan**. The goal of which is to better understand ecological condition of park natural areas and develop management strategies and associated costs for improving their ecological quality and function.

Technical Management Plan **PROVIDES MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES** for additional natural areas planted as part of park design included in the Master Plan
