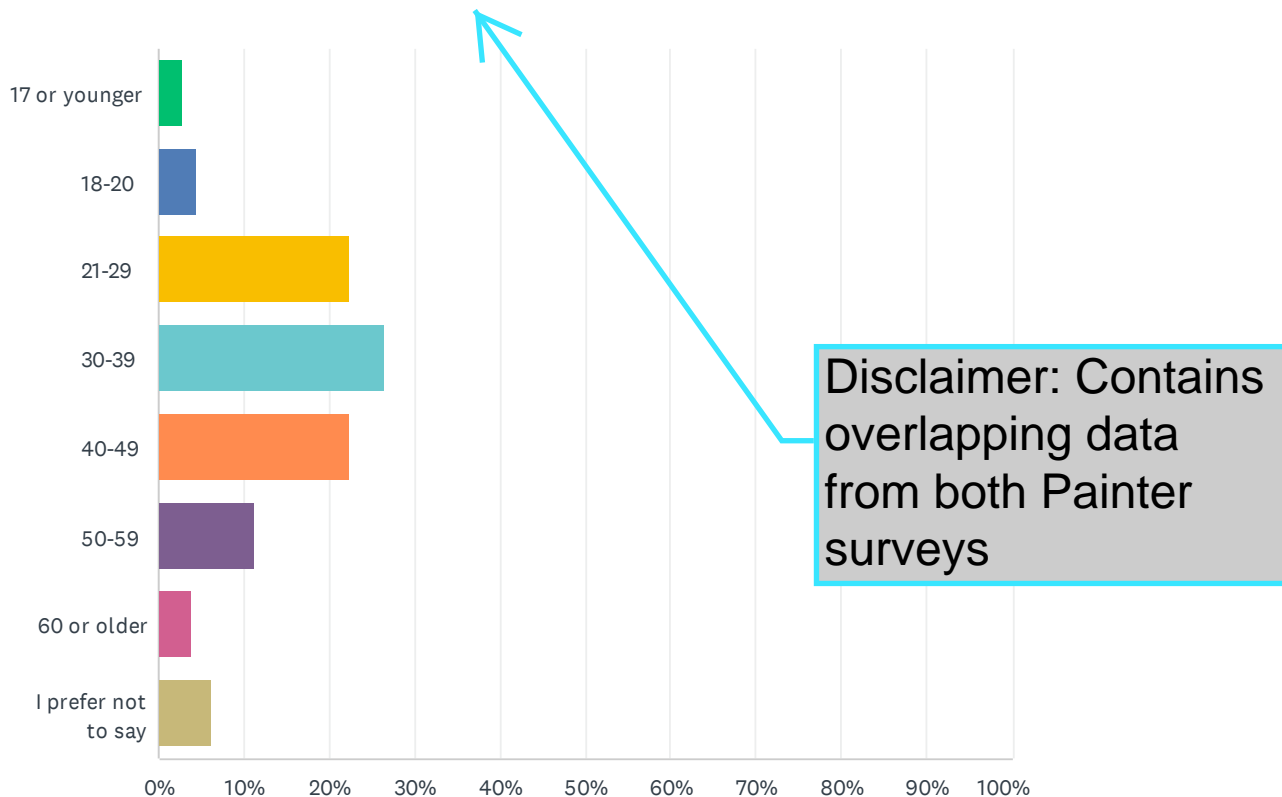

Q20 Do you rent or own your home?

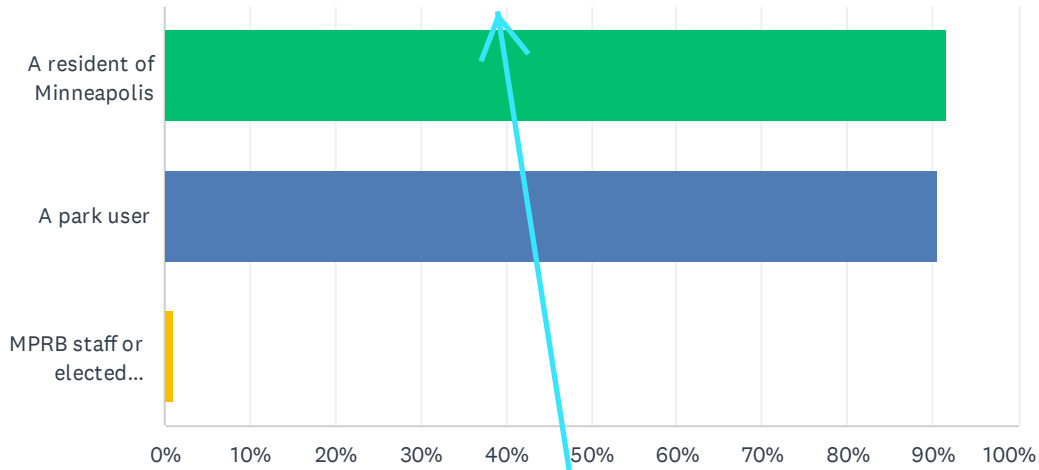
