Community Engagement Summary

Development of the community engagement deliverables was determined based upon available funding and seeking feedback of proposed improvements, which were identified in the North Service Area Master Plan NSAMP, approved in 2019. Of the ten proposed improvements identified, the feedback received through community engagement ranked the following items highest:

- New adventure play hillside slide and ADA paths
- New full court basketball and 1/2 court basketball
- Auxiliary building improvements
- Picnic area improvements

Online Survey Summary

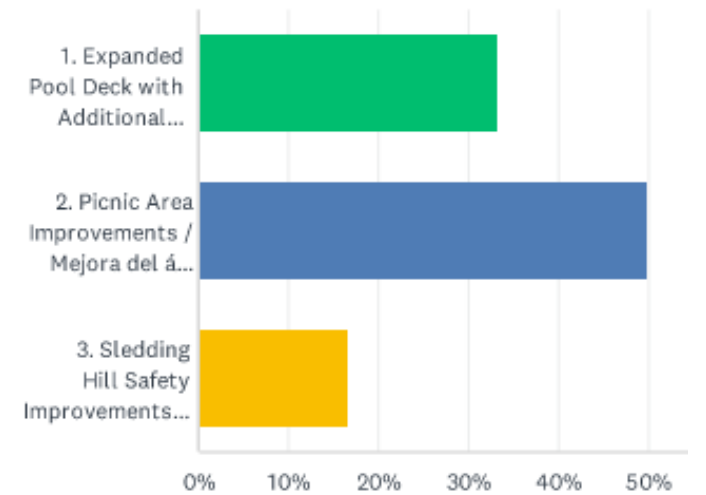
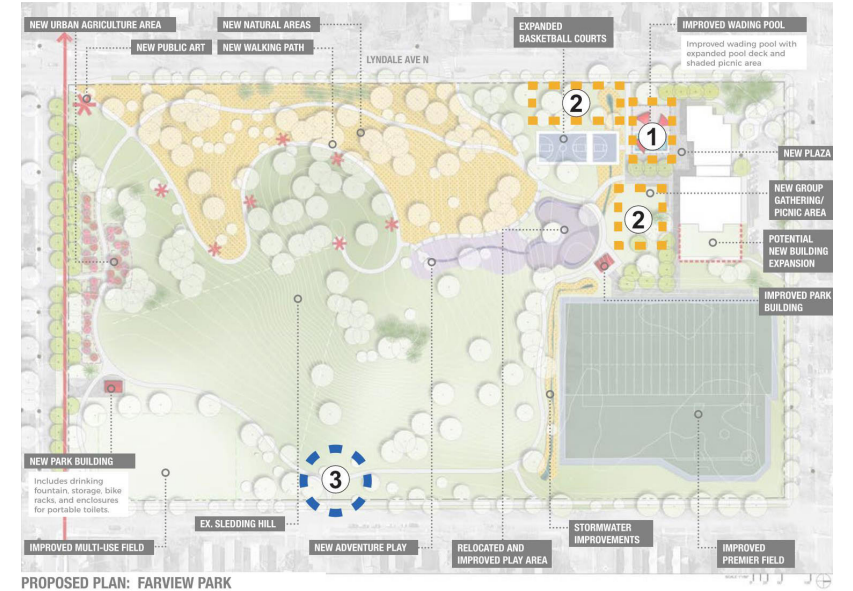
