- Load-in may begin at 5:00 pm, which is when techs arrive to set up the PA. Allow as much time as necessary for your group to have a timely sound check and be ready to perform at 7:00 pm.
- System Specs:
 - Allen&Heath SQ6 mixer - 32 ch, 6 aux
 - EV QRx series Cabinets and Subs
 - 4 monitor mixes with 4 EV EKX stage monitors available
 - Reverb/Delay/Comp/Gate
 - Mics/DIs/Cabling/Stands provided, sanitized after each performance
- A limited quantity of chairs (40) are available for performances. *This amount may vary*
Chairs are sanitized after each performance. In the cases when there are not enough chairs, we will use benches from the seating area to supplement where we can.
- A limited quantity of music stands (12) are available for performances. *This amount may vary*
Music stands are sanitized after each performance
- The weather is always a consideration, and one that we can never predict. The Music in the Parks weather policy is as follows:
 1. If there is a chance of inclement weather, the Concert Coordinator is in contact with the sound techs and the performers the day of the event, and a decision is made together to continue or cancel. Since the weather can change rapidly, a final decision may be made as close to show time as possible.
 2. Audio equipment **MUST** be shut down if lightning is seen. Absolutely no exceptions. Use common sense. Be safe. Do not let electrical equipment get wet.
 3. In compliance with MPRB policy, if the Heat Index is 105° at 3pm, coordinators will meet to decide on the weather decision. The Concert Coordinator will be in contact with the group prior to canceling. ***Copies of the MPRB weather policy will be provided to sound techs***
 4. There is no rescheduling of shows.
- Temporary parking passes will be emailed each week to artist contact. Please distribute as needed and place on the dashboard of your car with the writing facing up. Free parking is available on the streets nearby. If you travel with a trailer, or if you need to drive into the park expressly for (un)loading purposes, please inform the sound techs upon your arrival, and they will assist. Tour busses require a special permit to be on park grounds. More information on parking can be found by visiting the MPRB parking website.

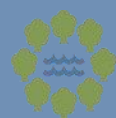
Parking

- ◆ If you need to unload/load equipment at the stage, enter the park from Godfrey Parkway and stay on bike path (black arrows on map). Hazards **MUST** be on and ***please have sound techs help navigate through pedestrian traffic.*** All vehicles **must be moved** after unloading and loading equipment.
- ◆ Bathrooms are located in the picnic pavilion/Sea Salt building. There is also a water fountain inside this pavilion with faucet for water bottles.
