Comments from Initial Concept Plan:

- By basketball:
 - 8 year old: put in half pipe. More benches.
 - 5' tall fence around court. Keep walk & fence gate.
 - Not too much fencing. 48th St. side only. Keep it short.
- By pool:
 - Keep both gates at pool.
 - People cut through from bathroom to pool.
 - More bike parking (by pool).
 - Like this (pergola) with new entry. Yess.
 - Vines over pergola essential!
- By picnic area:
 - Balance keeping shade/trees with seating. No tables in this zone is a loss
 - More seating and connected seating by play + pool
- By field:
 - Enclosed play area for dogs
 - Add lines for soccer field + goals for soccer.
 - Kids like the sledding hill—keep. Yes!!!
 - Add lines for football field and/or soccer field
 - Turf low priority. Fuller soccer is at Washburn.
 - Off leash dog area closest Lyndale.
