

# Music In the Parks

## Minnehaha Falls Noon

Tuesdays at NOON

Load in information: Load in may begin **two hours** before show time, at which time a tech will arrive. Please plan accordingly, so sound checks are done in a timely manner and performances start on time.

- System specs:
  - All-in-one 600-watt PA system with 10-channel powered mixer with full range speakers.
  - 4 XLR combo inputs, Two ¼” instrument lines, Two ¼” stereo, two 1/8” stereo inputs and Bluetooth
  - Output for one monitor, one Sub out and two ¼” output for speakers
  - FX; Delay, Reverb, on the passport itself
  - Mics, DI boxes (2), Cabling, Mic stands, Chairs provided (40)
  - There are no choir risers available.
  - Parking passes for this location with additional parking in the neighborhood.
  
- Weather Considerations:
  - Rain in excess will bring upon a cancellation. We work with Weather Underground and MSP airport. To keep equipment safe as well as the public a decision will be made based upon the weather in the area.
  - Lightning will cause a stop in programming if seen. If there is lightning in the area, we must shut down for 30 mins. If the lightning continues it will cause a cancellation.
  - Heat access of 105° can be dangerous for band staff and public. The MPRB considers the Music in the Parks series and adult family program, therefore can continue in certain circumstances of heat. Supervisors will make final decisions on heat-related cancellations. Performers can also cancel for heat and weather-related reasons if performers feel uncomfortable.
  - Air quality can be hazardous to adults, and children who have breathing conditions. MPRB supervisor staff will meet to make decisions based upon

our usage of the Air Now weather app and based upon guidelines in the MPRB policies.

- **Copies of the weather policies will be given to sound techs.**
- There are no reschedules of shows
- Parking passes will be valid in all Minnehaha Falls parking lots. They do not allow you to park illegally, the parking passes do not work for the roundabout at the Sea Salt nor the meters around the park.
- To unload equipment at stage please enter Biking path south of the playground. Hazards must be used, drive slowly as there will be pedestrians.
- Bathrooms are in the Sea Salt building to the west of the stage. Water refill station is inside the bathroom area as well as inside the Sea Salt eatery
