- Load-in may begin at 10:30 am for noon concerts, staff will be on site to set up the sound system. If you need to load-in earlier, please contact the Concert Coordinator. Allow as much time as necessary for your group to have a timely sound check and be ready to perform at noon.
- Passport Venue Series 2 System Specs:
 - All-in-one 600-watt PA system with 10-channel powered mixer and full-range speakers/Bluetooth® audio streaming
 - 10 inputs (4 XLR Combo inputs, Two 1/4" Instrument/Line, Two Stereo 1/4", Two Stereo 1/8", One Stereo Bluetooth)
 - Line Out: Three - One Stereo 1/8" Phones/Line, one 1/4" Mono, one 1/4" Sub Out, Speaker Jack: Two 1/4" Left and Right (Stereo)
 - -4, Shure 58 Microphones. 1, Shure 57 Microphone. 4 Microphone stands, 4 XLR cables, 2, 1/4 cables, 2 DI boxes, 2 extension cords, 2 power strips.
 - Space provided for a limited number of vehicles in the park.
 - Sound technician will be on site for set up and help with park provided equipment. (New)
- The weather is always a consideration, and one that we can never predict, the weather policy is as follows:
 1. If there is a chance of inclement weather, the Concert Coordinator is in contact with the sound techs and the performers the day of the event, and a decision is made together to continue or cancel. Since the weather can change rapidly, a final decision may be made as close to show time as possible.

2. Audio equipment **MUST** be shut down if lightning is seen. Absolutely no exceptions. Be safe. Do not let electrical equipment get wet.
 3. In compliance with MPRB policy, if the Heat Index is 105° at 3pm, all evening activities will be canceled. The Concert Coordinator will be in contact with the group prior to canceling.
 4. There is no rescheduling of shows.
- You will be issued a parking pass by Sound Techs to park inside The Commons Park. If you travel with a trailer, please inform the staff upon your arrival and they will direct you. **PLEASE NOTE:** These parking passes do not allow parking at City of Minneapolis meters. If you get a ticket at a City of Minneapolis meter you are responsible for the fine.
