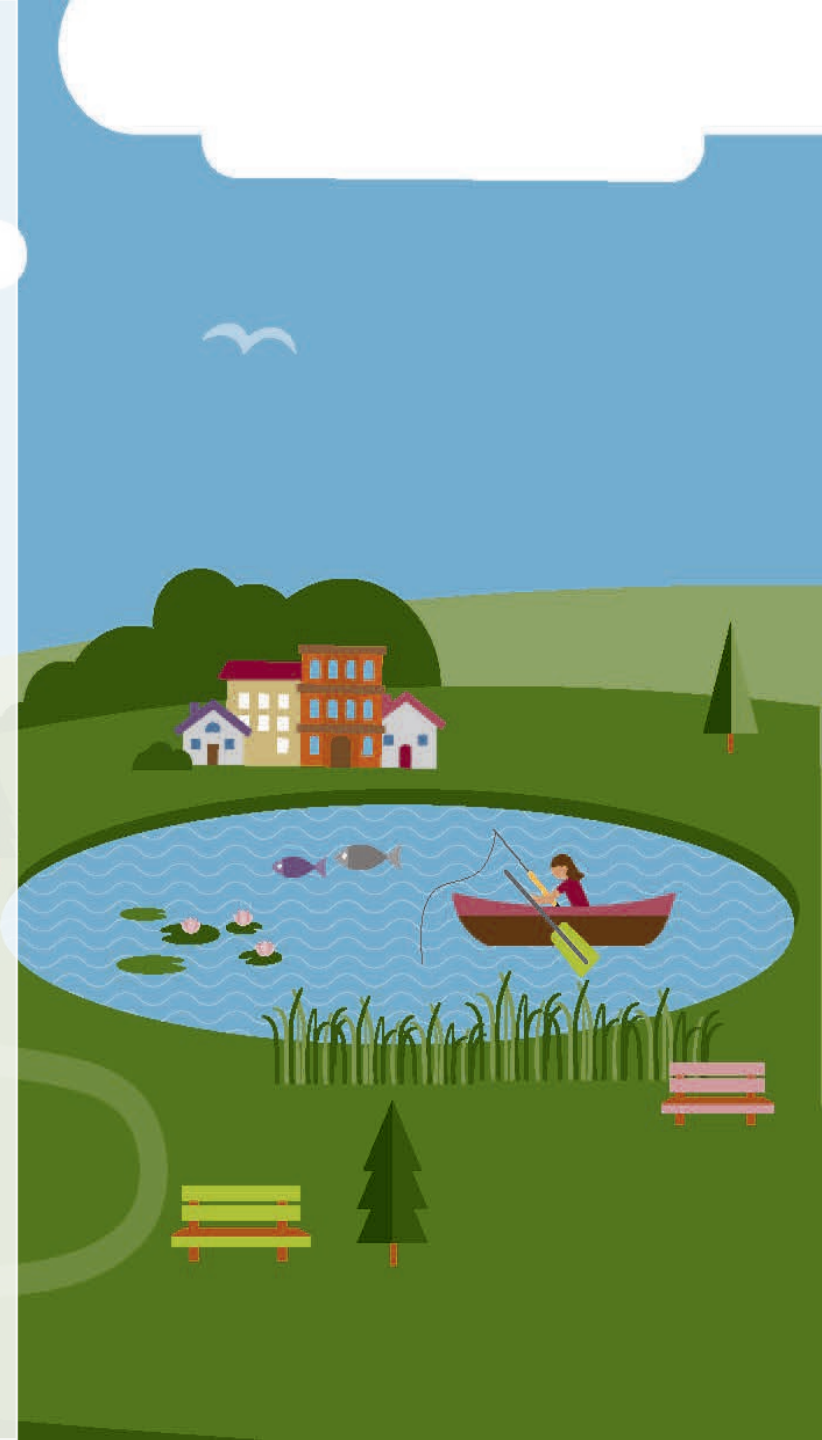
What's Next?
