

SOO LINE GARDEN LONG-TERM PLAN

Features

1. 100 + (100 sf.) garden plots
2. 8 (10' x 3') accessible raised beds
3. Five water access/compost locations throughout the garden
4. Accessible gathering space with shade structure and seating
5. Children's garden/classroom with benches
6. Garden shed with rain barrels
7. Stormwater treatment swale with native plants
8. 8' wide, accessible path with benches
9. Boulder retaining walls
10. Stair connection to gardens
11. Pollinator gardens (purple)
12. Shrub borders
13. Existing trees
14. Orchard trees and shrubs
15. Brush collection space
16. Fence line path connection
17. Garden fence
18. Boulder retaining wall with railing
19. Shared fruiting shrub bed
20. Accessible garden signage at entry points

The long term Soo Line Plan is a meandering, immersive garden space meant to function as a meditative nature filled space. This plan assumes a full site remediation*, replanting trees and screening shrubs, and incorporating an accessible crushed gravel path through communal spaces. Mulch paths intersperse the garden rows. Using boulder retaining walls, the Shed, Gathering space, Children's Garden, and brush collection are accessible spaces.
