CONDITIONS OF USE

Filming

Facility Rental Fee must be paid in full to be issued a Permit for Filming. Additional fees may be incurred based on amenities brought on Park Board land. All activities (set-up, filming, teardown, etc.) must take place within the time block indicated on the permit. Fires permitted in grills only. No driving or parking on the grass. No staking into the ground. All parking subject to posted restrictions. Applicant agrees: to bear all cost of policing: cleaning and repairing park property used pursuant to the permit, to reimburse the Park Board of all such costs incurred by the Park Board; to indemnify the Park Board and hold the Park Board harmless from any liability to any person resulting from damage or injury in connection with the permitted event proximity caused by the action of the applicant, its officers, employees, or agents of any person under applicant's control; to limit all activities conducted on Park Board property to the terms of the permit; and that failure to abide by the terms of the permit or any other applicable laws, rules or regulations may result in revocation of the permit, retention of all or a portion of the damage deposit, fees, fines.

NOTE: The Minneapolis Park & Recreation Board has a "No Refund Policy." A change fee will be assessed for a change of date. Only one change of date is allowed. Any changes must be done ten (10) business days prior to the original event date.
